Since it began three years ago, the community farm has been home to a variety of animals including calves, pigs, chickens and goats.

The garden produces corn, tomatoes, Brazilian spinach, cabbage, beetroot, bok choy, capsicum, pumpkins, bananas, passionfruit, dragon fruit, pineapples and a variety of herbs and other edible plants.

The students are involved in every aspect of the farm from planning, building and constructing enclosures and shelters to preparing terraced garden beds, sowing crops, caring for animals, harvesting and selling produce.
