# Power tariffs

## Domestic

**Standard meter:** 19.23 cents per kilowatt hour plus fixed charge of 37.92 cents per day.

**Prepayment meter:** 21.14 cents per kilowatt hour.

## Commercial

**Standard meter:** 22.37 cents per kilowatt hour plus fixed charge of 59.20 cents per day.

**Time of use meter: (no minimum)** 28.63 cents per kilowatt hour from 6am to 6pm and 16.12 cents per kilowatt hour from 6pm to 6am plus fixed charge of 59.20 cents per day

## Alice Solar City

**Domestic:** 28.63 cents per kilowatt hour from 9am to 6pm during weekdays (including public holidays) and 16.12 cents per kilowatt hour all other times, plus a domestic fixed charge of 37.92 cents per day.

## Commercial demand tariff

This tariff is a total of the monthly energy tariff (kilowatt hours or kWh) plus the monthly demand tariff (kilovolt amps or kVA) plus the fixed daily charge of \$4.7755 per day (refer to table below).

## Application of tariff rates

The domestic tariff is applicable for premises intended to be used for residential purposes, excluding serviced apartments, but including:

- Electricity used on vacant land zoned for residential purposes.
- Churches or buildings which are used primarily for public worship.
- Lodging for members and staff of religious orders.
- Living premises of retirement villages (must be separately metered).

The commercial tariff is applicable for premises intended to be used for non - residential purposes, including:

- Electricity used on vacant land zoned for commercial purposes.
- Temporary supply (i.e. for building purposes).
- Motels, hotels, service apartments and any form of temporary accommodation.
- Shops, offices, warehouses and industrial/manufacturing plants.
- Mining enterprises.
- Farms.

## Territory GreenPower

Domestic:

- \$1.00 per week for a block of 647 kilowatt hours
- \$5.00 per week for a block of 3235 kilowatt hours
- \$10.00 per week for a block of 6470 kilowatt hours

Commercial:

- Eight cents extra per kilowatt hour and is consumption based.

Territory GreenPower will buy renewable energy certificates on your behalf, this is in addition to energy and supply charges which would normally apply.

## Power service charges

There are extra charges for some electricity services. These include:

- Establishment fee — \$56.00 (BH)\* / \$67.00 (AH)
- New supply service connection — \$113.59 (BH)\* / \$238.71 (AH)\*\*
- Reconnection after failure to pay — \$115.23 (BH)\* / \$343.37 (AH)
- Special meter readings requested by the customer — \$11.28

Prepayment meter:

- New prepayment meter connection — \$385.00 (BH)\*  
Another installation cost of \$115.23 will be charged, along with a connection fee of \$57.59 if a prepayment meter is changed back to a standard meter.

\* Business hour (BH) connections are from Monday to Friday, 8.00am - 4.30pm, single phase only.

\*\* Includes establishment fee.

# Water tariffs

Power and Water's water tariffs are a total of:

A charge for each kilolitre (1000 litres) used	
Rate	Amount per kilolitre
Domestic	\$1.0788
Commercial	\$1.0788
Government	\$1.1443
Standpipes <sup>^</sup>	\$1.5948

  

Plus a fixed daily charge based on the size of the meter or connection	
Connection	Amount
Up to 25 mm	45.06 cents
26 – 40 mm	\$1.1533
41 – 50 mm	\$1.7983
51 – 100 mm	\$7.2653
101 – 150 mm	\$16.2168
151 – 200 mm	\$28.8373
Above 200 mm – proportional to meter size (poa)	

<sup>^</sup> No fixed daily charge applies to standpipes.

## Sewerage tariffs

### Domestic

A fixed annual charge of \$513.65 applies to residential properties and vacant blocks able to be connected to the sewerage service. It applies whether the service is connected or not and regardless of the number of sanitary fittings in each residence.

### Non-domestic

For properties with none, one or two sanitary fittings, a fixed annual charge of \$513.65 applies. For properties with three or more, a fixed annual charge of \$513.65 applies, plus an additional amount for each fitting:

Sanitary fittings	Additional amount (each)
3 - 24	\$349.69
25 - 49	\$328.02
50 - 99	\$304.55
100 - 149	\$282.97
More than 149	\$274.01

## Water and sewerage service charges

There are extra charges for some water and sewerage services. These include:

- Connection — \$55.00
- Special meter readings requested by the customer — \$50.00
